Profile of the College

Cauvery College Gonikoppal, with a long history of 43 years has traversed many miles and after having crossed several hurdles, now heading towards progress and pursuit of excellence ushering a qualitative growth in higher education. With the emergence of **NAAC** and its quality drive in higher education, it has definitely brought about a sea change in our college campus in terms of expansion of academic programmes and additional infrastructure. Recently the college is accredited with **‘A’** Grade by **NAAC**.

A. Theme of the Seminar and Its Main Objectives:

The Small Scale Industrial (SSI) sector has acquired a prominent place in the socio-economic development of our country; Small Scale Industries though small in size, play a significant role in the Indian Economy. It is acknowledged by the Government that, alongside agriculture, small scale industry is an important segment of Indian Economy. An industry is said to be a Small Scale industry if its investment in fixed assets is less than `1 crore. Small Scale Industries contribute significantly to employment generation, dispersal of Industrial activity to rural and backward areas, ushering in all round economic growth by value addition, ensuring the mobilization of local capital and developing entrepreneurial skills. They contribute 8% of the country's GDP, employ about 60 million people through 2.6 crore enterprises and also contribute about 40% to the country's export.

B. Recession

The term 'recession' means a decline in a country's GDP growth for two or more consecutive quarters of a year. World economy is yet to come out fully from the grip of recession. As the cliché goes, whenever the US sneezes, the world catches cold. The economies across the globe has felt the effect. Indian economy is no exception.

Given the economic distress worldwide, the micro, small scale industries have been hit hard. Large number of workers have been laid off because of depressed demand, piled up inventory and squeezed credit market. A sector which provides maximum employment cannot be left to fend for itself without a major transformation led by the entrepreneurs, policy makers and also support organizations. In this backdrop, the Central Government in its annual budget 2010-11 raised the allocation for this sector from `1794 crore to `2400 crore. A high level task force committee appointed by the Prime Minister submitted its report and recommended to extend the stimulus package specific to this sector for one more year, besides calling for an easy procurement policy and creating a separate fund for the industry. The ministry also sought `5000- `5500 crore for the next three years for the implementation of the recommendations of the task force.

C. Objectives of the Seminar:

1. To understand and deliberate on the impact of world recession on Indian economy.
2. To discuss challenges faced by Small Scale Industries during the period of recession.
3. To deliberate and suggest the measures to meet the above challenges successfully.

4. To discuss the role of Government in enabling the SSIs to face the challenges and sustain the industrial growth.

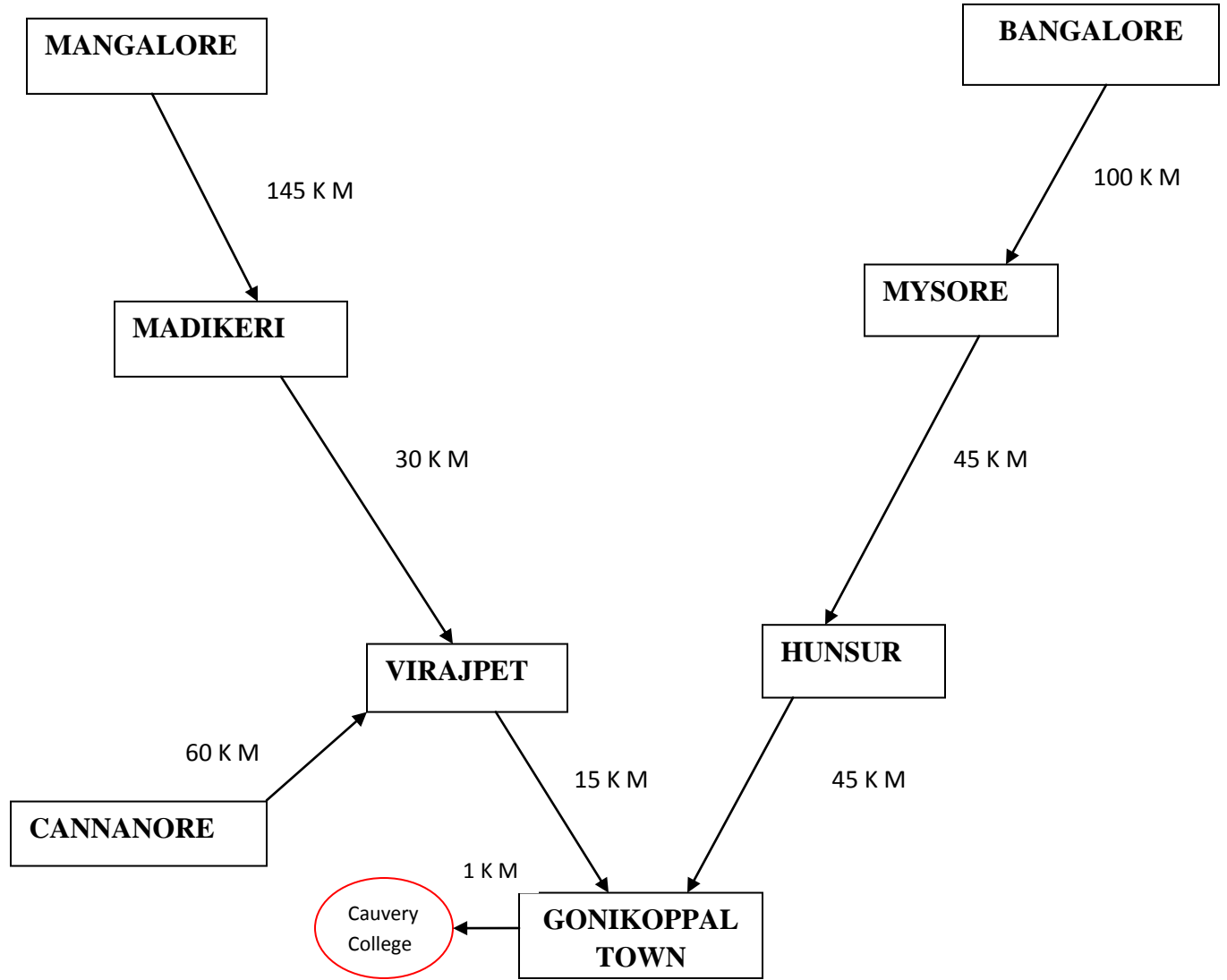
